Therefore, you're not alone if you've tried and failed to understand the brand's model numbers. If you're tempted to buy a Bosch dishwasher, your selection will most likely fall under one of the following series: This is Bosch's entry-level appliance. It is just as reliable as other Bosch series, at least where washing is concerned. The device only stumbles in the drying department. You can get one for \$700 or less. You have 12 machines to choose from in this series. 100 series models have a lot in common with devices in the Ascenza series. Most of them offer the smallest upgrades. Although, you may find a few on the market with significant improvements, such as a third rack, quieter opens, fast cycle, and hidden controls.
